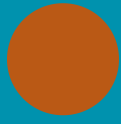

Camp Location

All activities take place at Courts Plus, both indoors and outdoors. Off-site activities are limited to neighborhood walks, nearby playground visits, and our annual field trip (additional registration is required).



Arrival and Departure

Drop-Off:

8:00 AM? Bring belongings into party rooms & check in with Youth Program Staff.

Later than 9:00 AM? Check in with front desk to see where ADC is located.

Pick-Up:

Before 4:00 PM? Ask the front desk where we are!

After 4:30 PM? Playground, party room, or meeting room

Please ensure your enrollment form lists all approved guardians. A new form is required each year.



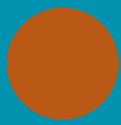
Hours of Operation

Camp Hours: **8:00 AM - 5:00 PM**

Extended Care: **7:00-8:00 AM** and **5:00 - 6:00 PM** (Additional fee; must be registered online each time).

A 15-minute grace period allows drop-offs as early as **7:45 AM** at the regular rate.

ADC is closed July 1-3 for Independence Day.



Ratios and Communication

Our ratio is **1 staff per 10 campers**, with a maximum of 30 campers per day.

We use the **GroupMe app** for updates, reminders, and occasional photos. Parents may message staff directly through the group.





What to Bring & Behavior Expectations

BRING:

Nut-free sack lunch and drink daily (microwave and refrigerator available).

Optional: \$5 lunch available and charged to your account.

Comfortable, weather-appropriate clothing for daily outdoor play.

Labeled items, especially towels.

Water Fun Day (weekly): swimsuit, sunscreen, towel, water shoes. Items may be stored for the summer if preferred.

Behavior: We expect all campers to follow camp rules and treat others with respect. Discipline may include redirection, time-outs, verbal warnings, or loss of non-essential privileges. **Repeated or severe behavior issues may result in removal from the program.**

Campers are expected to:

1. Stay with their group unless given permission.
2. Report illness, injury, or concerns to staff.
3. Respect staff, peers, and property.
4. Follow directions courteously.
5. Keep hands, feet, and objects to themselves.
6. Use positive, appropriate language.
7. Be responsible, helpful, and cooperative.
8. Maintain a positive attitude.
9. Have fun!



NEED TO KNOW INFO

Personal Belongings

We maintain an **electronics-free environment**.

- Gizmos are allowed.
- AirTags are permitted.
- Pokémon cards are not allowed due to trading issues.
- One comfort item is allowed if it does not become disruptive.

Lost & Found: Items are kept behind the Front Desk. Please label all belongings to help prevent loss.

Medications: Medication may only be administered with a completed and signed medication form. Contact Ayden or Carly if this applies to your child.

Illness & Injuries: Please keep your child home if they show signs of illness. If symptoms develop during the day, we will contact you for pick-up.

Communicable diseases or lice must be reported to the Youth Supervisor or Camp Coordinator.

Minor injuries will be communicated to parents; serious injuries will prompt immediate contact.

Cancellation Policy: Cancellations require **24-hour notice**, or the full day/session fee will be charged. **Submit cancellations through your online account and email Ayden at aochs@courtsplus.org**

Field Trip

Time: 12:30 PM–3:30/4:00 PM

Bring: swimsuit, towel, water bottle, life jacket (if needed), goggles (optional), signed waiver, bag for belongings

Ages: 5–12

Transportation: Fargo Parks bus + 6-passenger van (max 30 campers)

Additional Fee: \$10 (pool entry, ice cream stop, transportation)
